Arizona Employment First Guiding Principles

- 1. The current low participation rate of people who have disabilities in the workforce is unacceptable. Access to "real jobs with real wages" is essential if people who have disabilities are to avoid lives of poverty, dependence, and isolation.
- 2. All working age people who have disabilities can participate in jobs that provide for meaningful work, with pay at or above minimum wage, benefits, and opportunities for integration with other workers.
- 3. As with all other individuals, employees with disabilities require assistance and support to ensure success on the job and should have access to supports needed to succeed in the workplace.
- 4. All people, regardless of disability, have the right to pursue the full range of available employment opportunities and to earn a living wage in a job of their choosing, based on their talents, skills, and interests.
- 5. Outreach efforts should include diverse populations statewide.
- 6. Policies and practices should be conducive to the employment of people who have disabilities in general and Employment First principles.
- 7. Benefits counseling should be available to all people who have disabilities who want to work so that they understand the options available to them.
